

CEDAM Board of Directors: Call for Nominations

CEDAM is seeking regional CDC representatives and at-large representatives to serve on our board of directors. CEDAM's board consists of 18 members; 12 are CDC representatives with two representatives from each of the six regions across the state, and six are at-large members (at-large members do not have to represent a CDC). This year, we have:

- Incumbents up for re-election in regions 1, 2, 3, 4, and 6;
- One open seat in region 5;
- Two at-large incumbents up for re-election; and
- One at-large open seat

Anyone interested in running for a regional or at-large board seat is encouraged to apply! Candidates who run for a regional seat but are not elected have the opportunity to run for an at-large seat. At-large elections will follow the announcement of the regional election results.

The new board will be announced at CEDAM/CDAD's networking event after the first day of the [Building Michigan Communities Conference](#) on April 28, 2020.

Eligibility & Process

Board members serve a two-year term, and a board member may serve up to three consecutive full terms. In order to run for a regional CDC* representative position, you must be an authorized representative of a CDC that is a 2020 CEDAM member in good standing.

**A CDC shall be defined as a Michigan nonprofit corporation that has qualified as a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt organization as defined by the Code, involved in planning and implementing community housing and economic development activities, projects and programs in its community.*

CDC representative elections will take place in February. At-large elections will take place in March. New board members will be announced at CEDAM's annual networking event in April.

Commitment

Board members attend meetings every other month starting in June 2020 (call-in options are available). Meetings are on the fourth Thursday of the month from 12-2pm. Board members provide input on CEDAM's future direction and programming and are actively involved in CEDAM committees or programs.
